Grade 4	Physical Education and Wellness	Safety: A lifetime of optimal well-being is supported by prioritizing health and safety.	How can taking responsibility impact safety?	Students analyze and explain responsibility and how it can impact personal and group safety.

How can resolving conflict and healthy relationships be mutually supportive?	Students reflect on resolution and explain connections to healthy relationships.
